What to Do When a Member Drops

We've all been there. It's time for early birds and one of your members says they will not be renewing. Now what? First, and most important you need to remember a member who does not renew is still a member until the end of the trimester. Do not remove them from your roster until then, unless they contact you and personally request to be removed. Continue to invite them to all events and treat them like all other members through the end of the trimester. Second, make sure you take time to tell the member that they will be missed and are welcome back any time in the future when their situation changes. Adding value to a member's experience, even when they are leaving your chapter increases the positive energy of that member and your chapter. It does not help anyone when a member leaves frustrated and full of discontent. Third, inform the chapter service center that you have a member that will not renew. If you have many members that do not renew, contact the MVP ASAP and they can work with you on ways to support your chapter's membership sustainability.
