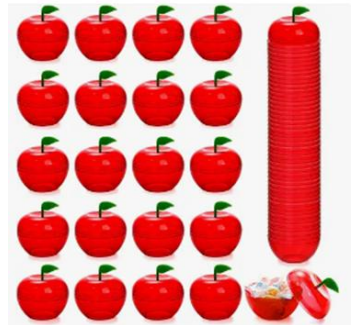
**Project Goal:** A little gift to share with teachers at the beginning of the year to help them get their year started with a smile. A good make-and-take project at a chapter meeting.

- Project Details:**
1. Place a green stem in the hole in the top of the apple
  2. Fill the apple bottom with the candy kisses
  3. Snap the top of the apple to the bottom
  4. Place the assembled apple in a clear bag
  5. Tie with a ribbon and a cute label!
