Planning Steps: Supplies You Will Need:

- Small shovels
- “I Dig You” Sign
- Candy Pieces
- Ribbon
- Rubber band
- Little treat bag



- Project Details:**
1. Slide your shovel into a small treat bag
 2. Scoop candy carefully into the shovel
 3. Tightly pull the top of the treat bag together and secure with a rubber band
 4. Tie a ribbon around the handle to hide the rubber band
 5. Secure “I Dig You” sign with glue dots
 6. Place a label on the back to promote your chapter
